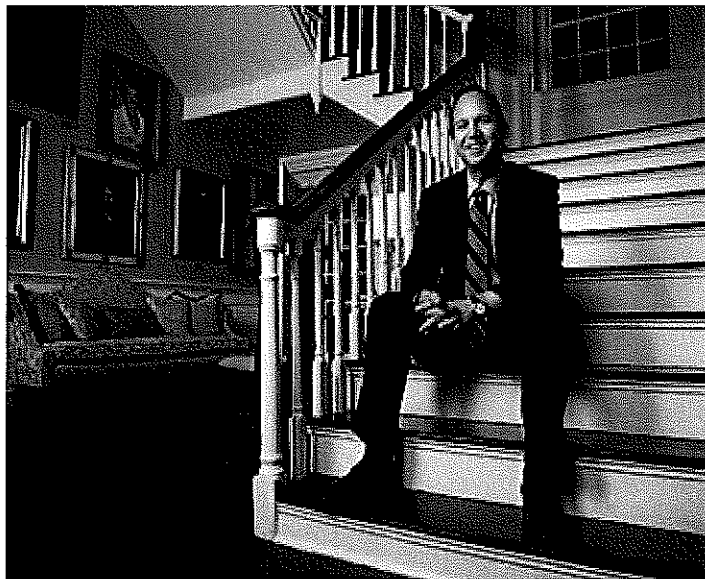
Asian Pacific American Heritage Month Celebration
